Nevada Department of Veterans Services (State)

Programs/Services Available:

- ⇒ *Nevada Veterans Home* - long term care facility for veterans and veteran dependents. Located in Boulder City, NV
- ⇒ *NV Veterans Cemetery* - burial available for veterans and veteran dependents. Located in Boulder City and Fernley.
- ⇒ *Veterans Advocacy and Support Team* - helps veterans, service members, and their families access all state and federal benefits to which they are entitled.
 - * Education and outreach events
 - * Wellness activities
 - * **Veteran Service Officers**

Veteran Service Officers (VSOs) are the certified specialists that help veterans through the application process.

Veterans Benefits Administration (Federal)

Programs/Services Available:

- ⇒ *Compensation* - monthly benefits (cash) to Veterans with disabilities.
- ⇒ *Special Monthly Compensation* - benefits payable in addition to the basic compensation rates in certain cases.
 - * Housebound compensation
 - * Aid & Attendance
- ⇒ *Pension* - needs-based benefit (cash) paid to:
 - * Wartime veterans
 - * Limited or no income
 - * Aged 65 or older or
 - * Permanently and totally disabled
- ⇒ *Dependency and Indemnity Compensation (DIC)* - monthly benefit (cash) paid to eligible survivors
